Today, all that remains are five buildings and a smokestack. Only one of them, the Kay Beard Building, is currently used. In *Eloise: Poorhouse, Farm, Asylum, and Hospital, 1839-1984*, this institution and medical center that cared for thousands of people over the years, is brought back to life.
